

**:: CONFIDENTIAL INFORMATION - PRIVACY POLICY****:: IN GENERAL**

Skyset SpA handles the personal data of the Client in full conformity to the applicable laws in matter of personal data processing (enclosed therein the dispositions of which to the D.Lgs. n.196/2003). In all its sites, Skyset SpA engages itself to collect, to record and to use and however to handle the personal data of the Client only for the purposes indicated in the present notice.

The data supplied by the Client are handled in order to improve the relationship with the client itself, as by example to ease the product purchase process, to supply services and assistance as well as to communicate news related to products and special offers of Skyset Spa. The personal information are not sold to third parties.

The personal data can be communicated, to companies not affiliated to Skyset Spa, subject to Customer's agreement, where necessary, in the respect of the modalities and purposes indicated in the present notice and on condition that such companies will demonstrate the same engagement as Skyset Spa regarding the protection of the personal data and the client confidentiality.

The customer can contact anytime Skyset Spa for further information on the norms that are protecting his personal data and to consult the supplied personal data, also with the aim to verify if these data needs to be modified and/or integrated or to ask for the cancellation. Skyset Spa engages to protect the security of the client's personal information by using adequate measures and procedures

**:: NOTICE ON THE USE OF PERSONAL DATA INFORMATION**

As has been stated in section 13 of the Italian D.Lgs 196/2003 or by any other Italian applicable law in this matter it is to be notified as follows:

**1.** The personal data (the "Data") You voluntarily supply to Skyset Spa by any mean or purpose (either by written, during the compilation of the registration form, orally or via e-mail) for the formalization of information requests of products, services, promotions, marketing activities, for the registration to promotional and informative events or for the purchase of products and services from Skyset Spa (further on "the Service") will be subject of processing, also by the use of digital and computer procedures, for the following purposes:

- a.** Directly connected purposes and tools necessary to the Service allocation and in accordance with the Contract General Conditions, each time applicable, between You and Skyset Spa.
- b.** Marketing research, advertising material distribution, marketing activity and dissemination of commercial information relative to Skyset's Spa or third parties products and services, performed in any way and by any mean.
- c.** Customer satisfaction survey on the quality of the rendered products and/or services and on Skyset's Spa performed activities.
- d.** Statistical analysis

**2.** The personal Data processing will be settled on the principles of fairness, lawfulness and transparency and of protection of the confidentiality and it's the same that will be processed and stored through information systems tools or on paper modality.

**3.** Your Data might be divulged by Skyset Spa to the following categories of subjects, for all the purposes previously indicated at the point 1 of the present regulation.

- a.** other Companies associated with Skyset Spa or third parties, which are in charge to perform instrumental and directly connected activities for the Service realization or with which Skyset Spa or other Companies associated to Skyset Spa has entered into a contract with, for functional commercial agreements regarding the distribution and development of the Service, of which there is available a detailed list on Yours expressed request; and / or
- b.** other Companies that offers goods and/or services belonging to commodity categories advertised over the Internet and with which Skyset Spa had entered into commercial agreements.

**4.** Your Data might be object of processing, with the aim as at point 1 of the present regulation, even through the following modalities: fax, phone, even without the aid of an operator, e-mail, SMS and other information systems and/or automatic communication means.

**5.** Your Data might be transferred abroad according and within the limits of Article 42 and 43 of the D.Lgs 196/2003 that is another corresponding forecast based on the applicable law.

**6.** In relation to the above mentioned Data processing, you are allowed to exercise all the rights as in accordance with art.7 of the D.Lgs 196/2003 or any other Italian applicable law in this matter (the complete text of the above mentioned article 7 is quoted below this document for Your opportune acknowledgement). Particularly, whenever you'll forward to Skyset SpA the cancellation demand of your personal information Data according to art. 7.3, letter b) of the D-Lgs 196/2003, Skyset SpA will immediately proceed with such cancellation, in the total respect of the applicable regulations, without further notice and/or communication and this will involve the immediate termination of the Service.

**7.** The collection of personal data for the purposes as at point 1, letter a), is of optional nature. Nevertheless, the missed conferring, even if partial, of the personal data requested for the purposes as at the previous point 1, letter (a) of the present regulation will affect the impossibility for Skyset SpA to proceed to the complete supply of the Service. The conferring of Data for the purposes of points b), c) d) that proceeds is optional and the eventual refuse by your side will not involve any consequence in the supply of the Service.

**Section 7 of the D.Lgs 196/2003**

**(Right to Access Personal Data and Other Rights)**

**1. A data subject shall have the right to obtain confirmation as to whether or not personal data concerning him exist, regardless of their being already recorded, and communication of such data in intelligible form.**

**2. A data subject shall have the right to be informed**

**a) of the source of the personal data;**

**b) of the purposes and methods of the processing;**

**c) of the logic applied to the processing, if the latter is carried out with the help of electronic means;**

**d) of the identification data concerning data controller, data processors and the representative designated as per Section 5(2); 19**

**e) of the entities or categories of entity to whom or which the personal data may be communicated and who or which may get to know said data in their capacity as designated representative(s) in the State's territory, data processor(s) or person(s) in charge of the processing.**

**3. A data subject shall have the right to obtain**

**a) updating, rectification or, where interested therein, integration of the data;**

**b) erasure, anonymization or blocking of data that have been processed unlawfully, including data whose retention is unnecessary for the purposes for which they have been collected or subsequently processed;**

**c) certification to the effect that the operations as per letters a) and b) have been notified, as also related to their contents, to the entities to whom or which the data were communicated or disseminated, unless this requirement proves impossible or involves a manifestly disproportionate effort compared with the right that is to be protected.**

**4. A data subject shall have the right to object, in whole or in part,**

**a) on legitimate grounds, to the processing of personal data concerning him/her, even though they are relevant to the purpose of the collection;**

**b) to the processing of personal data concerning him/her, where it is carried out for the purpose of sending advertising materials or direct selling or else for the performance of market or commercial communication surveys.**
